Admittance into the upper division nursing coursework for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree is dependent upon the following minimum requirements:

- A cumulative GPA of 3.0* or above.
- A cumulative GPA of 3.0* or above in the required sciences with a minimum grade of C in each required science course. Pass/No Pass is not allowed.
- Completion of all prerequisite courses. Lower division credit may be taken at any accredited college or university.
- All prerequisite courses must be graded with a grade of C or higher. Pass/No Pass is not allowed.
- Application deadline is February 1st.

*Please note that these are the minimum requirements. Admission to the program is highly competitive with average GPAs significantly higher than the requirement.
